Research Papers

Papers in all five sections

- Political
- Social
- Economic
- Cultural
- Historiography and Maritime History will be presented simultaneously.

Papers received on or before the due date will get precedence for presentation. More than one paper by a member shall not be permitted for presentation. The paper should be neatly typed in about 8 pages double spaced with end notes in word format. End notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and placed at the end. Papers in English will only be considered for inclusion in the Proceedings Volume.

Research papers submitted to the Congress shall strictly follow the style manual published in the SIHC website. In order to maintain the standard of our Proceedings, the Executive Committee has decided to apply 'Plagiarism Check' to all papers before selecting for publication.

Best Paper Awards

The South Indian History Congress has instituted two Awards 1) Kasturi Misra Memorial Young Historian Award and 2) Prof. Peddarapu Chenna Reddy & Dr. Subhashini Best Paper Award. Kasturi Misra Memorial Young Historian Award is for the best paper presented in all the five sections by scholars below the age of 45 (fortyfive). Prof. Peddarapu Chenna Reddy & Dr. Subhashini Best Paper Award is for the best paper in Social History Section, without any age restriction. Those who wish to consider

their paper for the Award may send their papers as hard copy (mention the name of the award on the envelop) to Dr. S. Ganeshram (General Secretary SIHC), Principal, Sri S. Ramaswamy Naidu Memorial College, Sattur-626 203, Virudhunagar (DT), Tamil Nadu- on or before 30 September 2023. Same paper will not be considered for two awards. Scholars have to submit a copy of age proof to apply for the SIHC Young Historian Award.
